- I. All State, only four (4) Commanders and Quartermasters will receive a cap or an appropriate Award. Post not in contention for all State Award will be considered for other Department Awards, based on each Post total score, which will be evaluated by the Awards Committee. This includes the whole Post concept for fiscal year 2018 – 2019. Any other Post obtaining at least 100% membership, a minimum of 4500 points and up in the top 50 Post in their division by June 1st will be submitted as part of the All-State team to National.

May 10th, 2019 is the cutoff date for all “All-State” Awards.

II. Membership/Recruiting/Donations:

The following will be adhered to:

- A. When Post is recruiting alone all donations received will be kept in the Post and QM will report the amount to the members. If Buddy Poppies are given out when donations are received, donations will be for the Post relief funds.
- B. When recruiting at all Departments’ organized sites, all donations will be forwarded to the Department QM, which will then be placed in Department Service Officers Out Reach Program and/or as Dept. C of A Directs.

III. Recruiting Award:

One (1) Round – Trip Air Ticket and \$500 expense to National’s 119th Convention in Orlando, FL. To win, for every New/Reinstated Member you recruit, your name will be entered in the drawing pot. Deadline for this award is June 18th, 2019. Drawing will be June 22nd, 2019 at the State Convention, the Aloha Banquet Night.
