I. THE FOLLOWING IS THE COMMANDER’S AWARD PROGRAM:

A. Certificates:

1. To all Committee Chairpersons and volunteers who meet their goals
2. To up to 2 other volunteers designated by each Post Commander or Committee Chairman.

B. Plaques:

1. Top three (3) outstanding volunteers or members who recruit the highest overall numbers in new, reinstated and life members.
2. To comrades who excel. Each Post Commander may recommend one member from their Post. Deadline is May 8, 2021.

II. STATE COMMANDER’S INCENTIVES:

A. \$150 for Recruiting 15 new members by December 31, 2020

B. Department Recruiting Team Shirt for:

Oahu – Recruiting 7 new or reinstated members

American Samoa, Kauai, Maui, Molokai and Hawaii – Recruiting 4 new or reinstated members

Deadline for shirts is April 30, 2021.

III. ALL STATE COMMANDER CRITERIA:

| B. Post Increase in Life Membership by May 8, 2021 | 500 points |
| C. Post Increase in Legacy Life Membership by May 8, 2021 | 500 points |
| D. Post Adopt at least one Military Unit or one JROTC Unit | 500 points |
| E. Post Attends one Adopted Unit Function | 500 points |

VI. ALL STATE QUARTERMASTER CRITERIA:

- A. Bond** – Form submitted and paid to Department Headquarters by September 1, 2020 500 points
Received at Department Headquarters after September 1, 2020 50 points
- B. Admission Fee** One dollar per new member paid to Department at least quarterly 300 points
- C. Proof of 2020 Federal Income Tax filed** 500 points
- D. Proof of current year DCCA license registration by May 8, 2021** 500 points
- E. Quarterly Audit** Submitted to Department within 30 days after the
quarter ending - April 30th; Sept. 30th; Dec. 31st and March 31st 1000 points/quarter

- A. ALL STATE**, only four (4) Commanders and (4) Quartermasters will receive a cap or another appropriate award. Posts not in contention for an All State Award will be considered for other Department Awards, based on each Post's total score that also includes the whole Post concept as evaluated by the Membership Committee. Any other Posts obtaining at least 100% membership, a minimum of 4500 points and which are in the top 25 Posts in their division by June 1, 2021 will be submitted as part of the All-State team to National.

**May 8, 2021 is the cutoff date for completion of All-State award requirements.
Items marked with ** are required for award consideration.**

B. MEMBERSHIP/RECRUITING/DONATIONS:

The following will be adhered to:

1. When Post is recruiting alone all donations received will be kept in the Post and the QM will report the amount to members. If Buddy Poppies are given out when donations are received, donations will be for the Post relief funds.
2. When recruiting at a Department organized event, all donations will be forwarded to the Department QM and distributed in the Department Relief Fund, Out Reach Program, Veterans and Military Service and/or as the Department Council of Administration directs.

C. RECRUITER AWARDS:

1. RECRUITER INCENTIVE DRAWING:

One (1) Round Trip Air Ticket and a \$500.00 stipend to be used for attending the VFW National 122nd Convention in Baltimore Maryland will be awarded. For each, new or reinstated member you recruit, you receive one entry in the drawing. Deadline for entries is June 10, 2021, with the drawing being held at the State Convention, on the Aloha Banquet Night.

2. STATE CONVENTION MEALS:

Any recruiter, personally recruiting 30 or more new or reinstated members will receive free meals at the 83rd State Convention.
